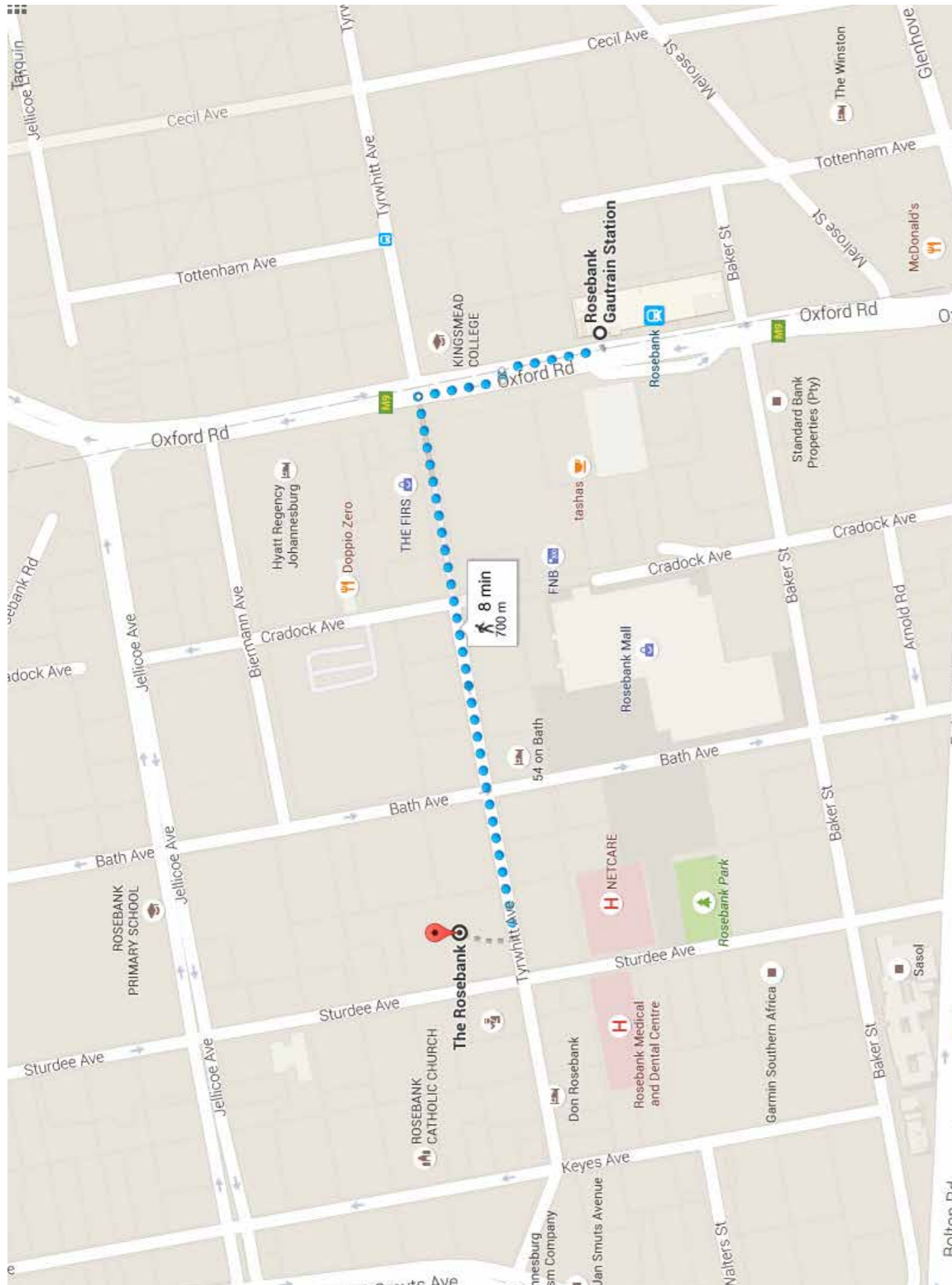

Editorial Guidelines to Authors

- Only abstracts which address research conducted in the field of haematopoietic stem cell transplantation are acceptable.
- Papers may be a description of clinical studies or case reports. An interesting case report may be chosen as a topic in the “Clinical Debates” section.
- The abstract title must be in title case, followed by the names of the authors and their institutional affiliations. Underline the name of the presenting author.
- The abstract should be sent in electronic form to the symposium secretary. The font size should be 12, Arial or similar.
- The body of the abstract should include the following headings: Introduction, Methods and Patients, Results and Conclusions.
- The body of the abstract should have up to 2500 characters (spaces included). Single space all typing and the text should be a single paragraph.
- The abstract should be self explanatory, have all the relevant information and not include vague terminology (such as “...results will be presented...”)
- Abstracts submitted by e-mail to Coleen.Fredericks@uct.ac.za by Monday 28 September 2015. You will be advised of acceptance/decline on Monday 5 October 2015.
